NEPALI OUTREACH MINISTRY

2024 Review

I give thanks and praise to God for His faithfulness throughout the year 2024. By the grace of God, and with your prayers and support:

Teaching: I was able to partner with Bible schools in Nepal—Nepal International Theological Seminary (NITS) and Himalayan Graduate School of Theology (HGST)—and train 40 students who are now serving in various leadership roles in churches and Christian organizations in Nepal, S. Korea and Malaysia.

Midwest Bible Study: led Bible study and fellowship among Nepali-speaking churches throughout the U.S. Midwest region. Each week, approximately 20 members attended the Bible study.









Leadership: The Nepali Outreach Ministry has played a significant role in supporting leadership within the Nepali immigrant community's churches in the USA, as well as collaborating with the Bhutanese Nepali Churches of America (BNCA) to organize leadership training sessions and seminars.

Mentorship: I had the privilege of working closely with Pastor Ran Limbu (Wisconsin), Pastor Joseph Bardewa (Pennsylvania), and Mr. Chhetra Timilsina (Nepal) as a mentor in their ministry and academic studies. Mr. Timilsina, a professor at Midwest University in Nepal, converted to Christianity from Hinduism and has since become a committed believer. He is currently

pursuing an MDiv degree and requested that I serve as his mentor and academic advisor. We meet twice a week to discuss his research, academic progress, and personal spiritual journey.

October - December 2024, Ministry Activities

Midwest Weekly Bible Study

Midwest pastors and leaders meet via Zoom every Monday from 7 PM to 9 PM for Bible study and prayer. In the last three months, Pastors Richard Suberi from North Dakota and Olak Sunuwar from Illinois have devoted these weekly sessions to teaching on mission and Old Testament study. This dedicated group, which now includes approximately 17 pastors and leaders, represents a wide range of locations, including Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, St. Louis, South Dakota, Iowa, and Pennsylvania.
